GOAL: to improve HIV prevention uptake among young queer couples.

This study developed and piloted a relationship skills-focused HIV prevention for young gay and bisexual men and their partners to increase the uptake of HIV prevention strategies (like HIV testing), increase relationship communication skills and reduce HIV transmission rates among participants.

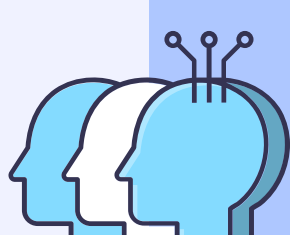

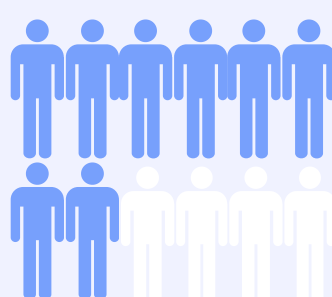

GENERAL PARTICIPANT Demographics

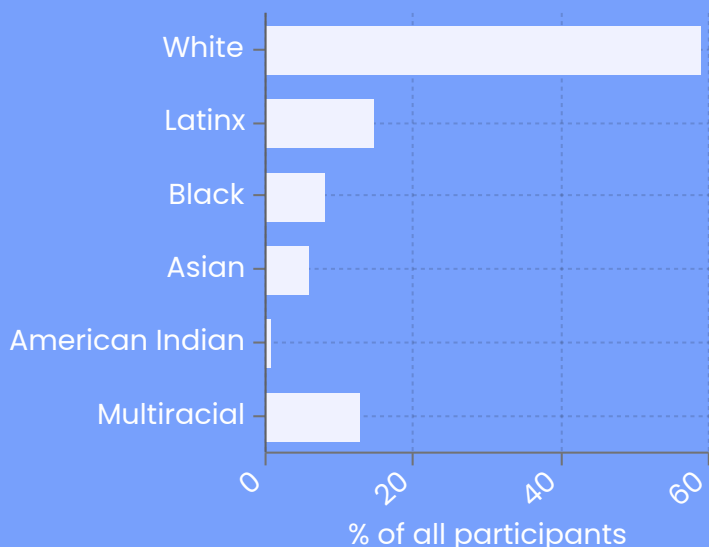


The age of the average participant was **20 years old.**

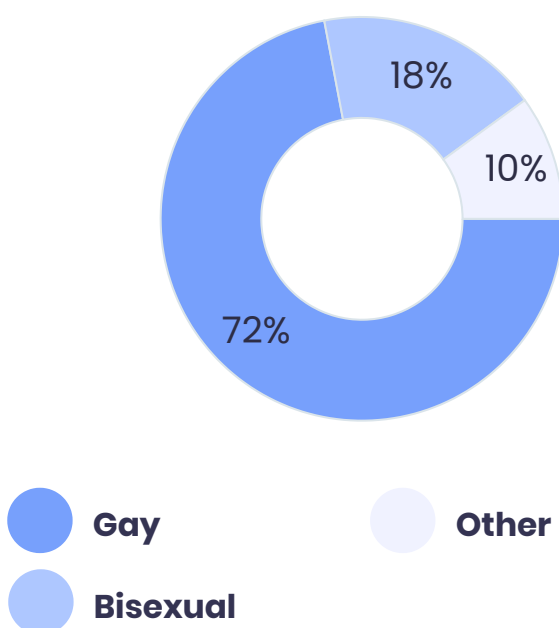


4 of every 12 participants identified as transgender men or non-binary

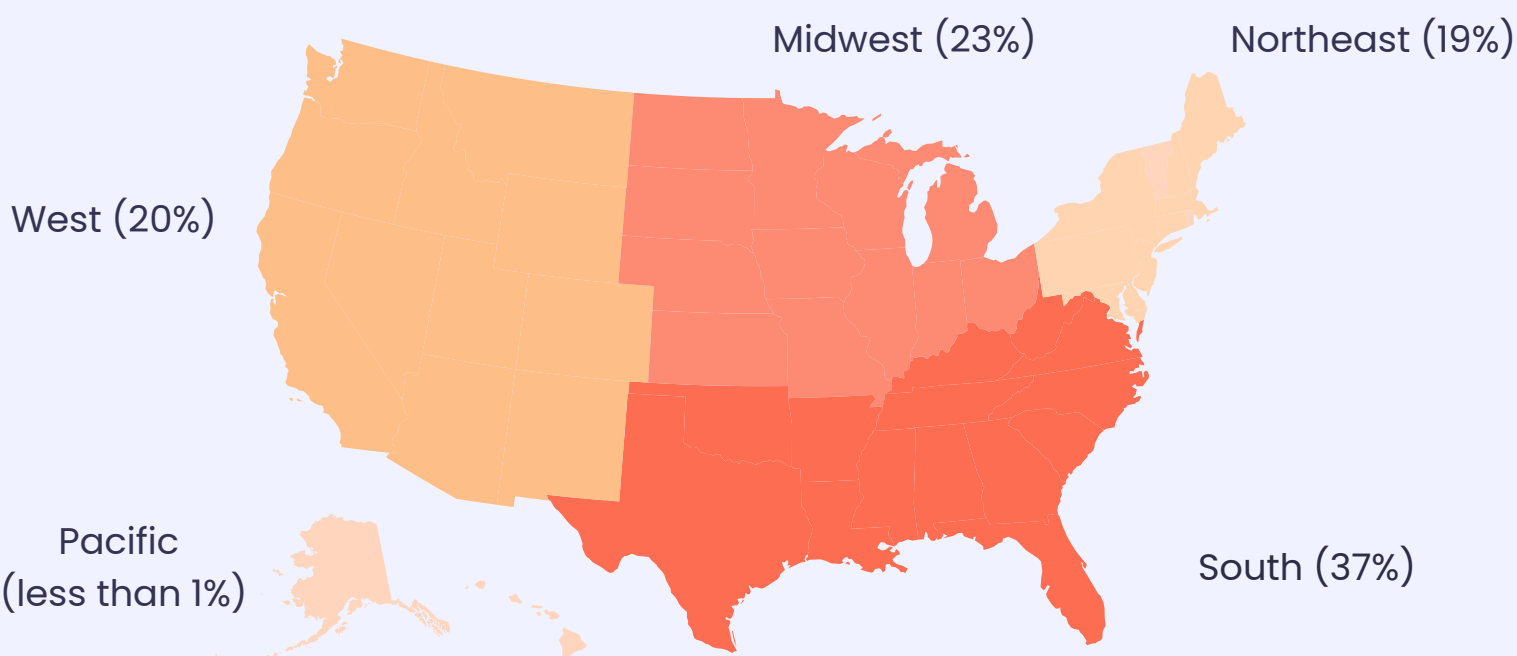

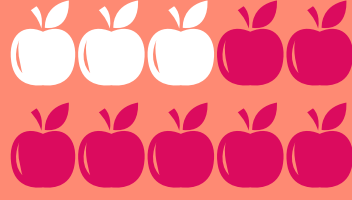

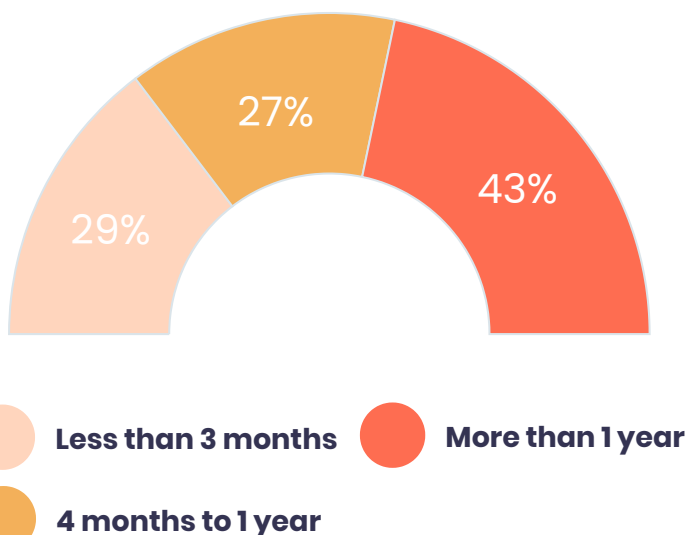

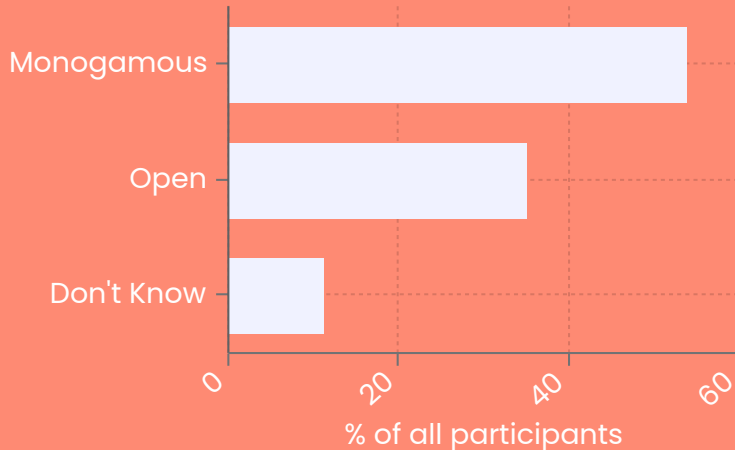
