### Total # **Proportion of All** of **Study Description Participants** Sites LYNX is a theory-driven mobile app to 2 support young men who have sex with **46**% LYNX men seeking HIV/STI testing and PrEP. **COMPARE** is looking for differences between two HIV prevention apps. Each COMPARE app's components will be combined into 12% a composite for public dissemination. of 381 YouTHrive is an adapted version of the "Thrive With Me" intervention to support youthrive 8 youth living with HIV by providing peer 20% support, resources, and self-monitoring. of 208 P3 is a mobile app that uses game mechanics and social networking features to increase PrEP use among **17%** young men and trans women who have of 246 sex with men.

# **Background**


Researchers at the University of South Florida recruited individuals in the Tampa Bay area for iTech's randomized controlled trials from 2018 to 2021.

Individuals were recruited using a variety of online and in-person strategies, including social media ads, outreach events, and collaborations with community partners.


The following charts describe basic characteristics of 158 participants in iTech studies at this research site.

# Age (%) 15-17 18-20 21-23 24-26 27-30 0 10 20 30 40 50






# Racial Identity (%)\*
